

Information for Professional Services Visits at the Fayette County Jail

The administration of the Fayette County Jail desires to work closely with those individuals or entities who provide professional services to the inmates being housed in the Fayette County Jail. In order to accommodate those providing professional services in an efficient and timely manner it is important that you are provided with the following information.

The jail follows a daily schedule of inmate activities and jail activities which may impact your visit. During the below listed times wait times to see an inmate may be longer than normal. If at all possible, please do not schedule your visits during these times. Inmates are not available during the times underlined below, without prior approval of the Jail Administrator.

Inmate sleeping hours: 10:30pm to 6:30am

Head Count: 6:30am – 7:00am

Head Count: 2:15pm – 2:45pm*

Head Count: 10:15pm – 10:30pm*

Lunch Service: 11:30am -12:45pm

Supper Service: 5:00pm – 6:15pm

* May start the visit prior to the beginning of head count, however, you will be required to stay in the jail with the inmate until head count has been completed.

If at all possible, please avoid scheduling your visit on Monday's, or the Tuesday following a Monday holiday. These days are very busy in the jail with numerous inmate movements to accommodate court dockets.

In-Person Visits:

Except for Attorneys and/or Clergy, professional visits are from 7:00am to 7:00pm daily.

We encourage you to schedule in-person visits at least one (1) hour prior to the time you wish to visit by calling 740-333-3783. At the prompt press 8 to connect to Central Control which will schedule your visit. By scheduling the appointment, the inmate you are visiting will be available more quickly than non-scheduled visits.

Visits may be conducted in a room with the inmate, or if requested with a glass barrier between the visitor and inmate.

Virtual Visits:

The Fayette County Jail provides a web-based platform to those providing professional services to conduct a visit virtually, with audio and video. This is a free and secure service once your account has been approved. This service is not recorded or monitored.

To obtain access to the virtual visitation platform email inmate.transportation@fayette-co-oh.com please provide your name, organization, telephone number, and a copy of a government issued ID and professional credentials. You will be contacted by a member of the jail staff to complete the enrollment process and instructions on how to use the system.

Although you will schedule an appointment via the virtual visitation website you MUST call 740-333-3783 prompt 8 to schedule the inmate to be available. We encourage you to schedule virtual visits at least one (1) hour prior to the time of the appointment.

Telephone Contacts:

Attorneys may request inmates have the availability to contact them through the inmate phone system. An attorney can make that request via email to inmate.transportation@fayette-co-oh.com please provide your name, organization, telephone number, and a copy of a government issued ID and professional credentials. There is a fee for this service. Telephone calls to attorney's are not recorded or monitored.

General Information:

Please keep in mind that the jail has limited rooms for professional visits, therefore even with a scheduled visit you may have to wait for a room to become available.

Professional visitors will only be permitted to bring items into the jail that are required to conduct the business at hand.

All visitors are subject to search.

If it is discovered that professional visitors are allowing family/friends of inmates to visit during virtual visits or telephone calls, the privilege of virtual visits will be revoked.

Scheduled visits will be given priority over walk-in visits.
