The Ohio Sheriff, the "First to Serve" since 1788! The Fayette County Sheriff's Office is accepting applications for ***FULL-TIME OPERATIONS (PATROL) DEPUTIES***. We are seeking motivated and dedicated individuals that are looking to make a difference in our community. The following are some of the benefits that our new team members are eligible for:

- Starting salary is **\$23.69** an hour. After completion of a 1-year probationary period, your salary is **\$27.81** an hour. Cost of living increases are outlined in the Collective Bargaining Agreement. At 5 years of service, staff members enter longevity pay earning 2.5% followed by .5% every year through your 25th year totaling 12.5% on top of base pay and any cost of living increases;
- 2 weeks paid vacation from year 1 thru 8; 3 weeks paid vacation from year 8 thru 14; 4 weeks paid vacation from year 15 thru 24, 5 weeks paid vacation at year 25; *full-time employment with other PERS employers count toward the rate you earn
- You can begin using your earned vacation time soon after hire date.
- 12 paid holidays a year
- Opportunity to earn up to 5 additional paid time off days (vacation) during a calendar year
- Officer in Charge and Field Training Officer hourly incentive pay opportunities
- Opportunity for specialty assignments to include; ERT (Emergence Response Team), U.S. Marshal's Fugitive Task Force, Crash Reconstruction Unit, and Detective Bureau assignment;
- Health care benefits including dental and vision;
- Paid training;
- Tuition reimbursement opportunities
- Opportunity for Special Duty assignments;
- All equipment provided i.e.; uniforms; body armor; outer carrier, duty belt, etc.,
- Representation by the FOP (Fraternal Order of Police)

Requirements: High school Diploma or GED, Ohio Peace Officer Certification, Valid Driver's License, and ability to pass back ground check including CVSA (Computerized Voice Stress Analysis). Applications are available for download at www.faycoso.com
